Joining FHS PTSA (Parent Teacher Student Association) is an easy way to stay involved in your child's education. Our PTSA belongs to the National PTA family. The mission of the PTA is to support and speak on behalf of children and youth in the schools, in the community, and before governmental bodies and other organizations that make decisions affecting children; to assist parents in developing the skills they need to raise and protect their children; and to encourage parent and public involvement in public schools. PTA works for the benefit of all children. In Farmington, we provide parents with the latest information and district information:

Of course, our PTSA offers several activities in which you and your students can be involved:

- **FHS Club/Sport Fundraising:** Using our Charitable Gaming license issued by the State of Michigan, we sponsor off-site Millionaire Parties for fundraising. FHS clubs can provide two volunteers (18 years and older) for a day to earn a grant for their club or booster group. As required by the state, volunteers must be members of FHS PTSA.
- **Technology Initiative Fund:** Established to provide additional funding for the purchase of technology components and the support of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) program/activities.
- **Service Project:** November 12 with FHS Music Patrons & Interact: we'll pull tabs from collected cans.
- **Student and Parent Forum:** We will host free student/parent forums on Paying for College and on recognizing the signs of youth depression and preventing suicide.
- **Reflections Art Competition:** Students submit original works in literature, visual arts, photography, musical composition and dance choreography for school, district, state and national competitions. FHS had a national winner our first year of participation in 2011!

Our creation of a PTSA also provides our student members with the opportunity to apply for the C. Robert Maxfield Farmington PTA Council scholarship as well as state and national PTA scholarships. In its second year, three \$500 cash scholarships were awarded to FHS seniors.
